

At a recent inspection of the Vermont industrial school, Vergennes, made by Gov. Prouty of Newport, and Judge J. E. Weeks of Middlebury, and N. K. Chaffee of Rutland, members of the board of penal institutions, in consultation with an experienced architect, repairs, alterations and additions to the buildings, for which the legislature appropriated \$15,000, were planned. The plans include a 35x85 foot, two-story addition to the administration building, alterations and improvements to the girls dormitory, and additional fire protection to consist of more storage tanks and stand pipes. The addition to the main building will contain kitchens, pantries, and refrigerator rooms on the first floor, boiler and engine rooms, machine shops and coal storage in the basement and on the second floor quarters and printing, shoe, tailor, and sloyd shops.
